VOLUNTEER TO HELP THE HOMELESS IN OUR OWN BACKYARD!

Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN) of the Main Line: The Interfaith Hospitality Network of the Main Line (IHN), working with the local community, strives to end homelessness. IHN provides a caring and positive environment for homeless families, their children and single women while they design and implement a plan to break the cycle of homelessness in their lives. During the program, these families live in a different host church each week. Currently, our church partners with Central Baptist Church, which is one of 10 host congregations. We provide meals and childcare (if needed) from 6:30-8:30PM and overnight stays 2 times during the week the families are staying at Central Baptist. This happens 8 evenings each year.
