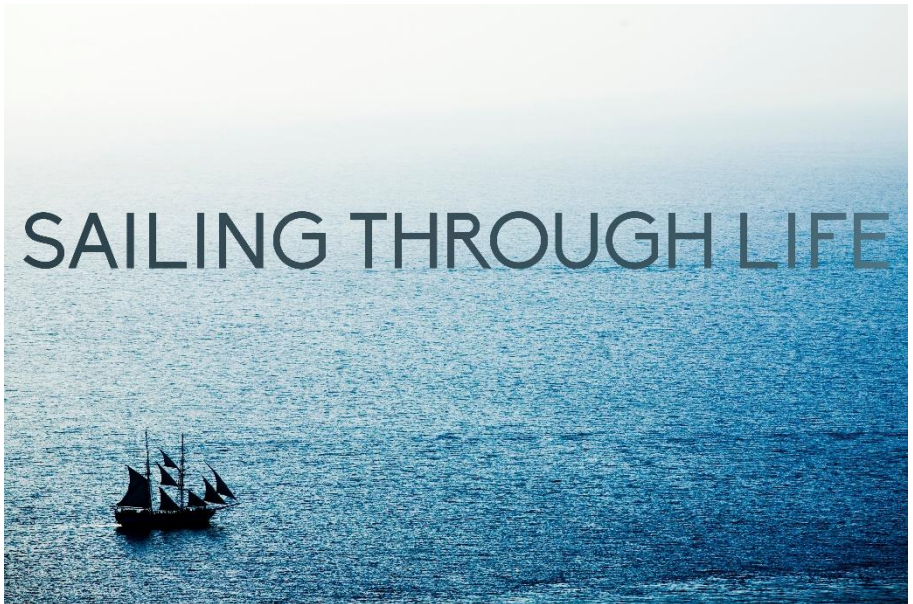

SERMON NOTES:

THREE FUNDAMENTAL QUESTIONS:

1) Who is the Captain of your ship?

- Describe your relationship with Jesus. Is there fear? Respect? Friendship?
- If Jesus is the captain of your ship, are you prepared to respond to his orders? Which biblical sailor do you relate to the most?: Noah? Jonah? Simon Peter? Why?

2) Are you a passenger, or crew member?

- Where are you in your Christian journey?: Are you being served? Are you serving others?
- Have you experienced the reward of being a “crew member?” What was it? Would you do it again?

3) Are you willing to cast off and set sail on your adventure?

- The dock is a very safe place. Is there anything keeping you from embarking on the adventure Jesus has planned for you? What is it? What can you do to overcome that barrier?
- One day in seven we return here for provisions. Are you receiving the supplies you need? Encouragement? Healing? Clear orders from the captain?
- Are you listening for the captain's voice? Are you doing what he says?
