SERMON NOTES:

- John Wesley was a philosophy professor at Oxford University. The integration of the intellect and the heart is fundamental to our Methodist heritage. What are you doing daily that helps you understand your faith better? What are you reading about the Christian life? Are you learning theology? Can you give an account of your faith when someone asks you a difficult question about your beliefs? Take time this week to write down your own account of your faith.

- John Wesley sought to glorify God in everything. At the age of 23 he stated, *"I resolve to dedicate all of my life to God, all my thoughts, and words and actions."* Have you thought about the purposes to which your life is dedicated? What do you glorify? God? Yourself? Who do you admire most? Often, the people who live their lives for the glory of God are those we admire most. Focus on one area of your life where you wish to glorify God better. What is it? What will you do?

SERMON NOTES CONTINUED:

- Most Americans refer to themselves as Christian. For you, what does it mean to be a Christian? Our renewal begins when we invite God to restore, change and heal us from the inside out. Is there something God is expecting from you? Is it something more than you are now? In prayer, ask God to guide your head, heart and hands.

- Methodism would have never happened if it weren't for Christians meeting in small groups. This is a critical part of our heritage; we find strength in our faith when we meet together outside of worship. Do you have that in your life? Are you meeting with others to grow your faith, study the Bible, become the person God wants you to be? Who is your small group?

- As we journey through the next five weeks together ask God to refresh and renew your faith and our community that we all may experience revival together.
